<u>Teacher Continuing Education</u>: Did you know that our teachers participate in continuing education each year to keep current in the field of early childhood education? As a reminder, our preschool will be closed on Friday, February 2^{nd} for teacher training. We can't wait to see what new and exciting things our teachers will bring back to their classrooms.

It's cold outside! Since outdoor play is such an important part of a child's natural development, we spend time on our playground when the temperature is above freezing and the ground is not saturated or covered with snow. Please remember to send your child to school with a warm coat, mittens, and a hat/hood for outdoor play. In wintertime our playground is mostly shaded, so layers will keep your little ones warm as they play!

<u>Inclement Weather Reminder</u>: Our program follows the Chesterfield County Public School System for closings due to inclement weather. If CCPS is delayed one hour, we will open one hour late but end at the normal time. If CCPS is delayed two hours, we will open two hours late and extend the day by one hour. Please send a packed lunch/larger snack for your child. If we need to make a closing decision that does not follow with CCPS, we will communicate directly with our preschool families.

Sight and Sound: Warm days in the middle of winter are so much fun! We love seeing the excitement of classmates playing together at the end of the school day on the church grounds. Please help us maintain the safe environment that we promote during the school day by monitoring your children through both sight and sound and teaching them to play respectfully with items on the church grounds. Thank you!!!
